BPSD-registrets uppbyggnad och data från registret har presenterats vid olika nationella konferenser.

År 2012: International Forum on Quality and Safety in Healthcare i Amsterdam

Ett av Sveriges bidrag handlade om kvalitetsregister och här bidrog bland annat BPSD-registret och Senior Alert

År 2013: ALCOVE, avslutningskonferens i Paris

ALCOVE (Alzheimer Cooperative Valuation in Europe) Ett EU-projekt med syfte att kartlägga vilka sätt det finns att samla in data gällande personer med demensdiagnos och hur vården och omsorgen kan utvecklas. Nedan en sammanfattning av det som togs upp gällande BPSD-registret.

Support systems for BPSD, example of Workforce – Skills

The Swedish BPSD Registry: Quality improvement programs for Professionals

Setting: nursing homes, sheltered accommodations for demented persons, BPSD-teams at specialist clinics

Aims: to improve and to reassure the quality of treatment and care of persons with BPSD.

This national quality registry initiated in November 2010, financed by the Swedish Association of Local Authorities and Regions (SALAR), has been supported by a special program directed to improve the situation for the most ill elderly from the Ministry of Health & Social Affairs. A web-based educational program is mandatory before joining the registry.

To date, 216 municipalities, 1505 units, nursing homes and BPSD-teams in specialised clinics and 5 350 patients are participating in the registry. The registry is spreading fast over the whole country. The development of BPSD profiles & different interventions are followed & evaluated continuously, with automatic feed back of the quality improvement and follow up.

This registry is used as a basement for quality improvement programs.

År 2013: Alzheimerkonferens i Iran

År 2014: Alzheimer's and Parkinson's Diseases Conference – ADPD i Geneve

Results:

The presentation will include data on more than 19 000 cases included in the registry during four years. Preliminary 3-year data showed a significant reduction of the NPI-score at patients with more than 50 points at baseline and a subsequent stabilization over time and a significant increase in the proportion of tailormade care-plans from 40% in 2011 to 80% in 2014.
